³²He made this very clear to them. So Peter took him aside and began to rebuke him.

³³But Jesus turned round, looked at his disciples, and rebuked Peter. "Get away from me, Satan," he said. "Your thoughts don't come from God but from man!"

³⁴Then Jesus called the crowd and his disciples to him. "If anyone wants to come with me," he told them, "he must forget self, carry his cross, and follow me.

³⁵For whoever wants to save his own life will lose it; but whoever loses his life for me and for the gospel will save it.

³⁶Does a person gain anything if he wins the whole world but loses his life: Of course not!

³⁷There is nothing he can give to regain his life.

³⁸If a person is ashamed of me and of my teaching in this godless and wicked day, then the Son of Man will be ashamed of him when he comes in the glory of his Father with the holy angels."
